

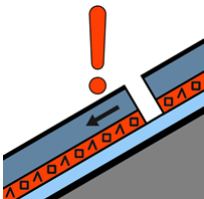

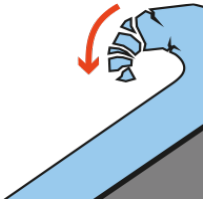
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



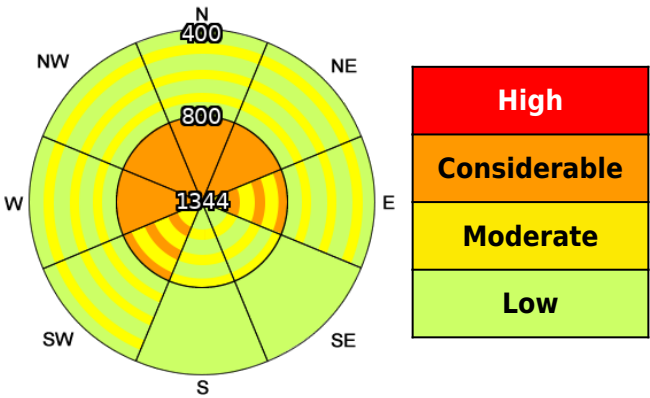
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be some re-distribution of snow. Areas of poorly bonded windslab will be present in sheltered areas. Greatest accumulations will be on West through North to North-East aspects above 800 metres. Other aspects will also be affected. Fresh cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry throughout the forecast period, with strong South-Easterly veering Southerly winds. The freezing level will be 400 metres.
