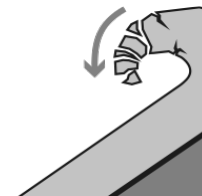

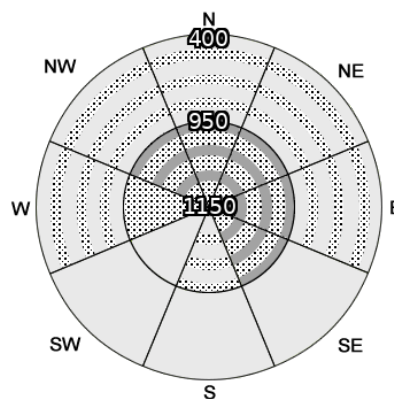

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poorly bonded deposits will persist in very sheltered locations on North-West to North-East aspects above 950 metres. Fresh unstable windslab will form on North-East to South-East aspects above 1000 metres. Also moderately bonded deposits will be found in steeper locations below these altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Some snow showers above 1000 metres this evening becoming more isolated overnight and during the day. Strong westerly winds overnight easing to fresh westerly by morning. Freezing level 1000 metres.
