Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will be subject to thaw conditions at all levels. Moderate to poorly bonded layers will persist on steep slopes mostly on West through North to Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Isolated instabilities will also be found on steep terrain features at lower altitudes. Elsewhere the snowpack will be well bonded and stable. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry with the freezing level expected to be around 2000 metres. Winds will be light from the South-East.

Comments

The snow will continue to thaw at all levels. Significant hazard from collapsing cornices.
