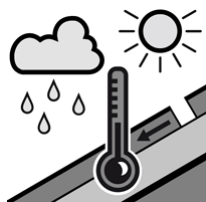


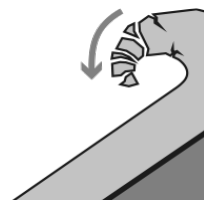

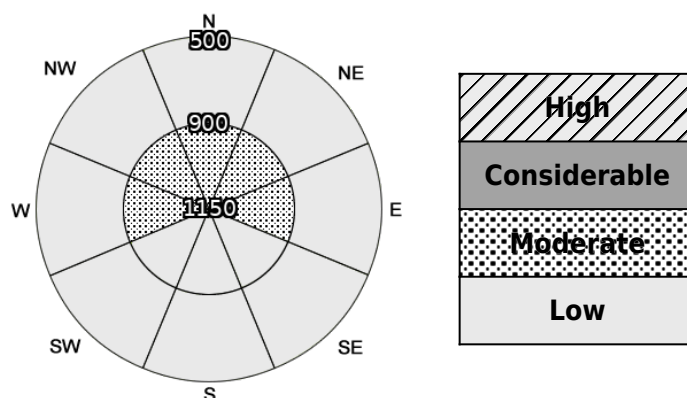
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Generally the snowpack will be well bonded and stable but moderately bonded instabilities will persist on West through North to Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Cornices will remain a hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry overnight with some cloud and light rain during the day. Winds will be light from the South-East. The freezing level will be above the summits.

Comments

Very good firm cover over most of the hills from around 700 metres.
