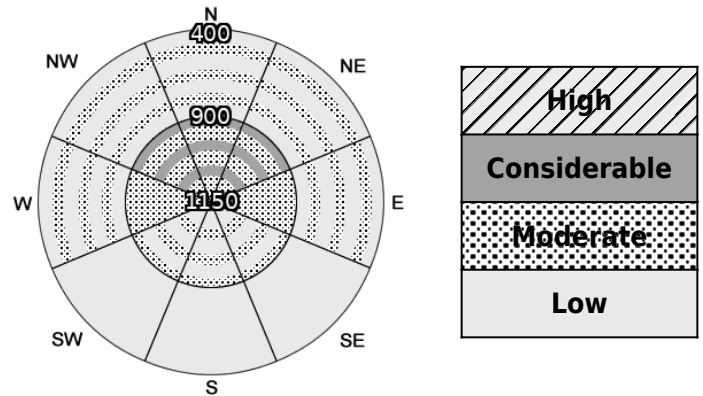
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain generally well bonded and stable on most aspects at all elevations, any new snow deposits are not expected to be significant only a dusting. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be an overnight frost at most levels and it will be mainly dry but with a chance of some light snow flurries, Easterly winds becoming South-Easterly. Generally dry through the day but again a trace of light snow with strong South-Easterly winds. The freezing level will be around 1000 metres lowering to 750m.

Comments

New snow amounts are not certain and could well be dry through the period. The snowpack will be icy in many places. It will feel cold in the strong winds.
