

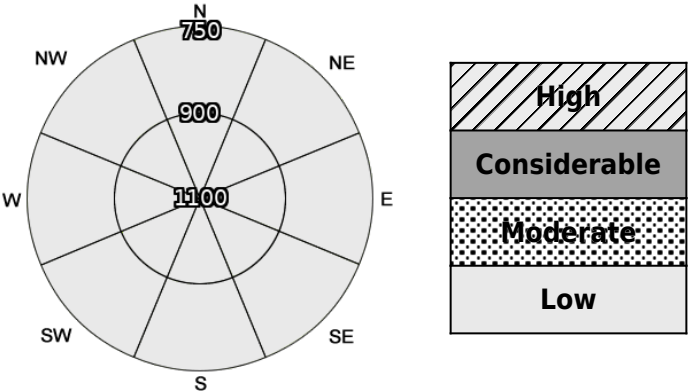

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Isolated, thin patches of new windslab are possible on North West to North East aspects above 900m but amounts expected to be very small. Stability will remain very good or excellent in nearly all locations. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Cloud cover increasing overnight when a few light snow flurries are possible. Clearer and brighter during the day with a cooling trend. Strengthening South Easterly winds.

Creag Meagaidh comparatively busy on Tuesday. Winds picking up and becoming strong later on Wednesday.
