

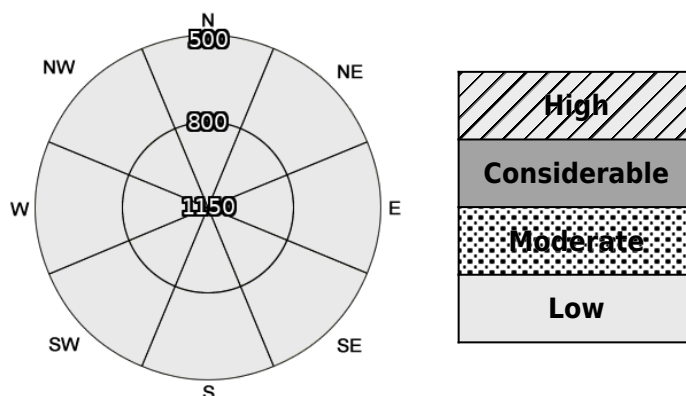

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 23/02/2013

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain very firm and icy in many locations. With only trace amounts of new snow expected overnight no significant change is expected to the general snowpack stability which will remain good. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The settled and cold conditions will continue with the possibility of trace amounts of snow overnight. Winds will be light to moderate North-East veering South-Easterly on Saturday.

Comments

Cold, settled conditions will continue. Possibility of trace amounts of new snow overnight expected to be insignificant. Ice forming readily on rocks, paths and in watercourses above 300 metres giving slick conditions in many places. With widespread snow-ice prevalent there is a serious run out potential onto exposed rocks and scree in many locations.
