

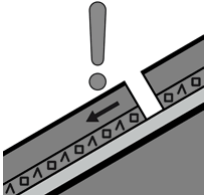

Avalanche Problems



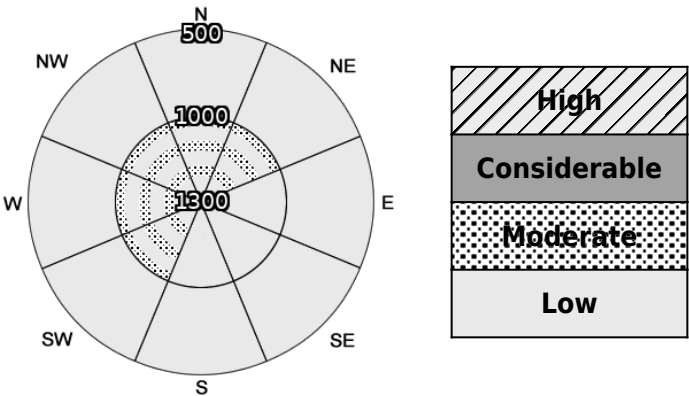
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

In general the old snowpack will be firm well bonded and stable throughout. Weaknesses below the strong surface crust will continue to affect mainly North-West to North-East aspects above 1000 metres on steep convex terrain. Isolated pockets of windslab will develop on South-West to North-West aspects above this altitude. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Occasional snow showers overnight will die out to leave a dry day. The freezing level will rise to 450 metres and moderate North-East winds will veer to the South-East.
