

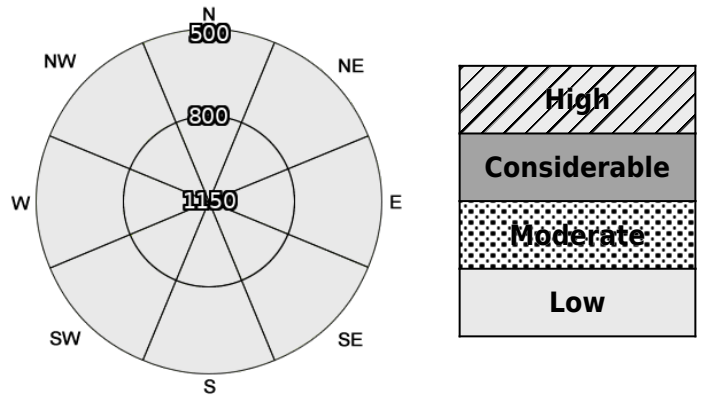

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 24/02/2013**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will remain very firm and icy in many locations. General snowpack stability will remain good. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

The settled cold, dry and calm conditions will continue overnight and on Sunday. Winds will be light to moderate mainly from the North-East.

**Comments**

The cold, dry and settled conditions will continue. Ice is forming readily on rocks paths and in watercourses above 300 metres giving slick conditions in many places. With widespread snow ice prevalent there is a serious run out potential onto exposed rocks and scree in many locations.
