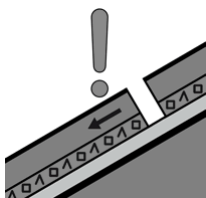
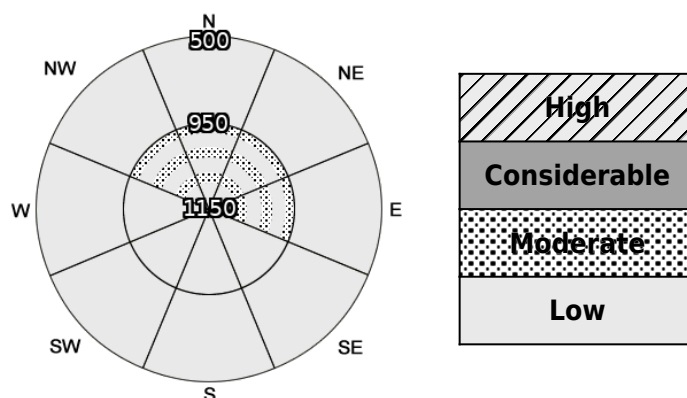


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 25/02/2013****Avalanche Problems****Persistent Weak Layers****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will mostly remain well bonded and stable with some isolated pockets of softer snow persisting on steeper sheltered locations on mostly North-West through North to Easterly aspects above 950 metres. Any new snowfall will be insignificant. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight there may be some isolated snow flurries with the winds remaining light from the North-East before veering South-East during the day. The freezing level will rise to 600 metres.

Unstable faceted crystals continue to develop under the hard icy surface layer.
