



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 28/02/2013

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The surface of the snowpack will soften in the generally milder conditions. Stability will remain generally good. Some shallow areas of fresh moist snow may be deposited on East to South aspects above 900 metres. These will be small and generally easily avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A cloudy day with some light rain or snow is expected. The freezing level will fluctuate between about 900 metres and 1600 metres. Winds will be from the North West.
