

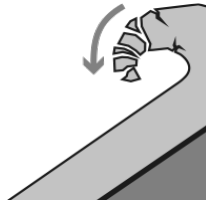

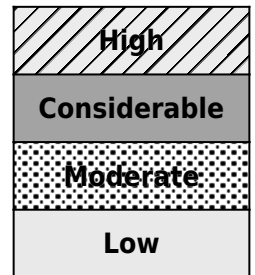
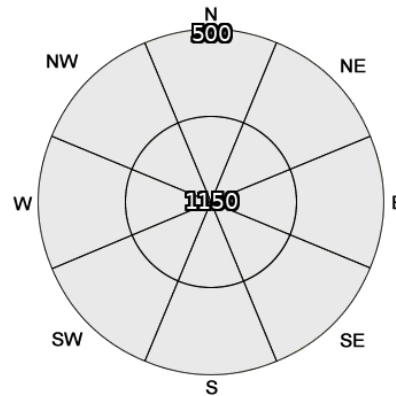

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Although the surface of the snowpack will soften slightly during the day with the milder temperatures, the snowpack will remain generally well bonded and stable. Any new, fresh deposits of snow are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain generally settled, however through the forecast period some light rain or sleet showers will develop mainly above 950 metres. The freezing level will be around 1000 metres. Moderate winds from the West-North-West will back to South-Westerly.

Comments

Overnight, cooler conditions will help prolong snowpack stability.
