

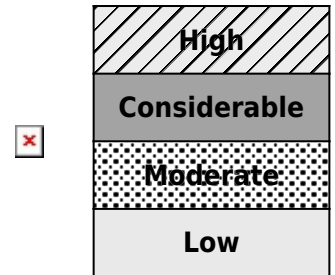
THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 05/03/2013

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Overnight, above 500 metres the moist surface layers of the snowpack will refreeze and consolidate, the surface layer will be firm and icy in most places. The snowpack will be generally well bonded and stable on all aspects and altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry with with fresh South-South-East winds these will veer to the West-North-West becoming variable and decreasing. The freezing level will be around 800 metres.

Comments

Summit temperatures expected to be zero degrees Celsius. The wet bulb freezing level lowering to 500 metres this will maintain a firm icy snowpack.
