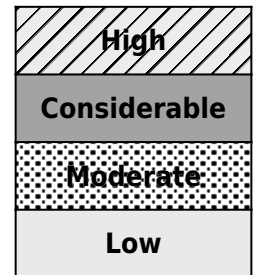
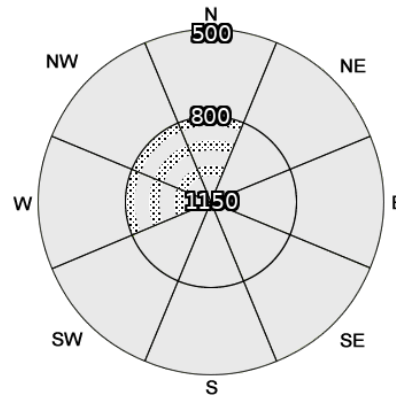
Wind Slab

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

With the strong Easterly winds and snowfall, areas of unstable windslab will develop in sheltered locations. New accumulations will be weakly bonded to the existing icy surface, the greatest deposits will be mainly on West to North aspects above 800 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight, it will remain dry with light South-Easterly winds, the freezing level will be around 700 metres. During the day strong winds from the East and light snow showers above 600 metres. The freezing level slowly rising to 1300 metres.

**Comments**

The new snow amounts may only be very light or a dusting and arriving later in the day. The old snowpack will remain frozen and icy.
