

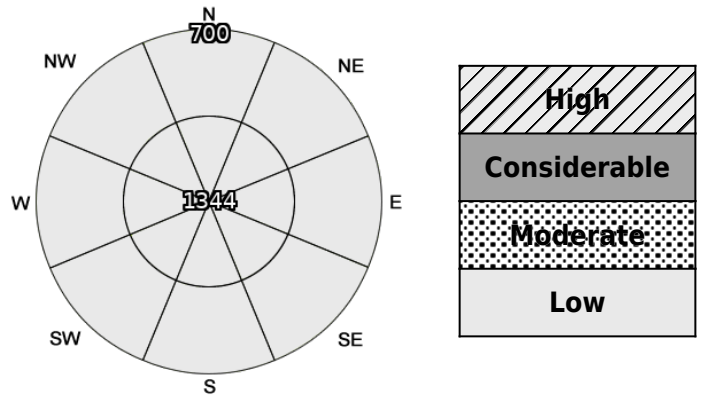

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will remain hard and stable. Some small deposits of windslab are expected during the afternoon on higher South-West to North-West aspects. These are expected to be small, shallow and generally avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry overnight and through the morning. A few light snow flurries are expected during the afternoon. The freezing level will rise to around 1200 metres. Easterly winds will strengthen.
