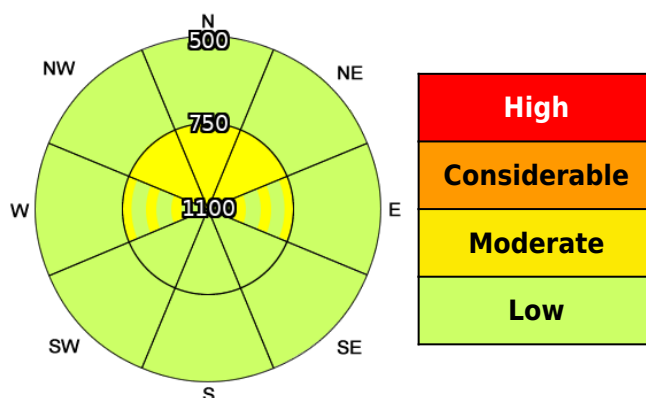

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some drifting will form new snow accumulations in high sheltered lee locations. Localised new snow instabilities will exist where windslab development achieves depth, on steep mostly North West through North to North East facing slopes and gullies above 500 metres. Old snow deposits will remain refrozen and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming cooler again with snow overnight and during the day above 300m. Winds will be very strong South Easterly.

Comments

Becoming wintry again for a spell. Very strong SE winds forecast making for difficult mountain conditions.
