

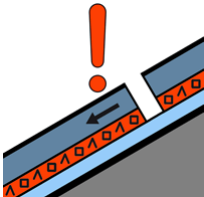

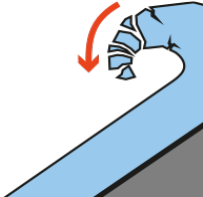

Wind Slab



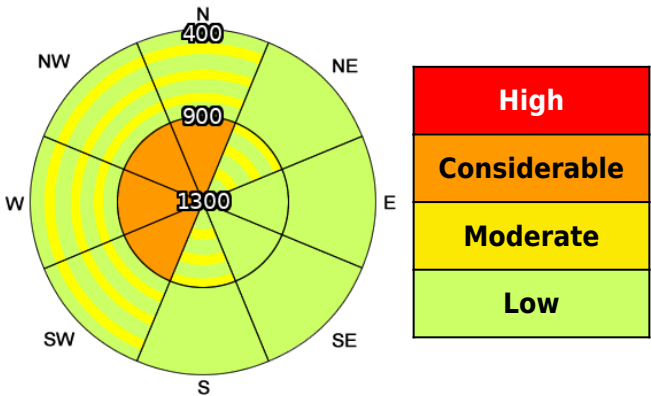
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Drifting will further load existing weaknesses within the snowpack. Avalanches are likely on steep South-West through West to Northerly aspects above 900 metres. Other aspects will be affected by localised instabilities due to cross loading. Cornices will be unstable. Wind exposed terrain will remain firm and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be very cold with occasional snow showers overnight and during the day. Winds will be strong East-North-Easterly.
