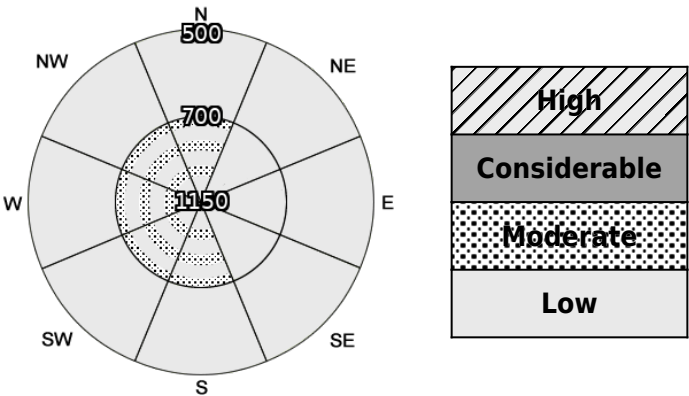
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh windslab will be deposited in sheltered areas, mainly on South through West to North aspects above 700 metres. Accumulations are expected to be generally localised. The old snowpack will remain frozen, icy and stable throughout the area. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds are expected to be strong East-North-Easterly throughout the forecast period. It is expected to be dry overnight with isolated snow showers during the day. The freezing level will rise to 300 metres during the day.
