

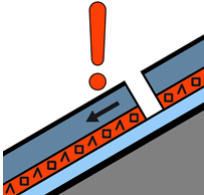

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected in the snowpack. In general it will be firm and stable, but with some areas of moderately bonded windslab on South-East through South and West to North-West aspects above 800 metres. Although this windslab will generally be shallow, a few deeper deposits will exist. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold and dry. The freezing level will rise to about 500 metres during the day. Moderate winds will be from the North.
