

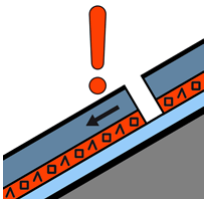

Wind Slab



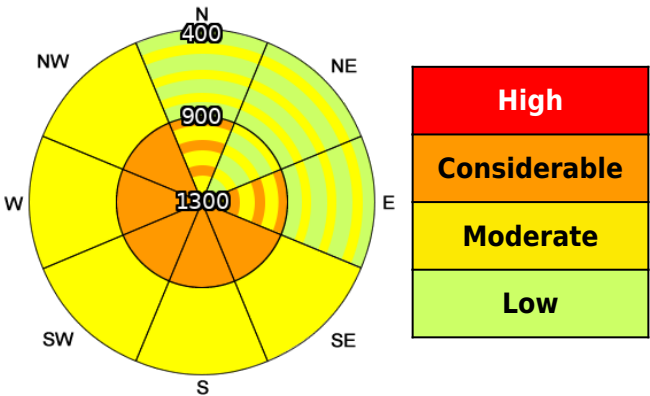
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will persist on West to North-Westerly aspects above 900 metres, with steep convex terrain especially affected. Additional poorly bonded windslab will continue to form on South-East through South to Westerly aspects mainly above 900 metres, where avalanches are likely. Other aspects will generally be scoured and stable but localised accumulations will be present here due to cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers and strong Northerly winds will persist throughout the forecast period. Freezing level 400 metres.
