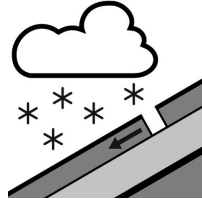

Wind Slab



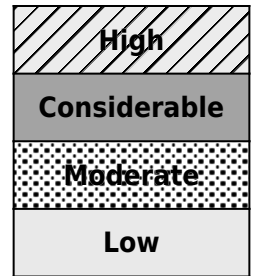
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of poorly bonded windslab will develop on South-East to South-West aspects above 800 metres; however, these deposits are not expected to be particularly extensive or deep, and should be mostly avoidable. On other aspects stability will be generally good. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be a few snow showers through the forecast period. Moderate winds will be from the North. The freezing level will be around 400 metres.
