

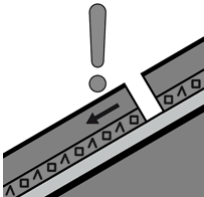

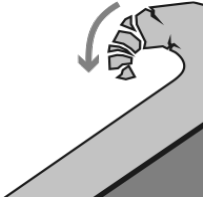
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



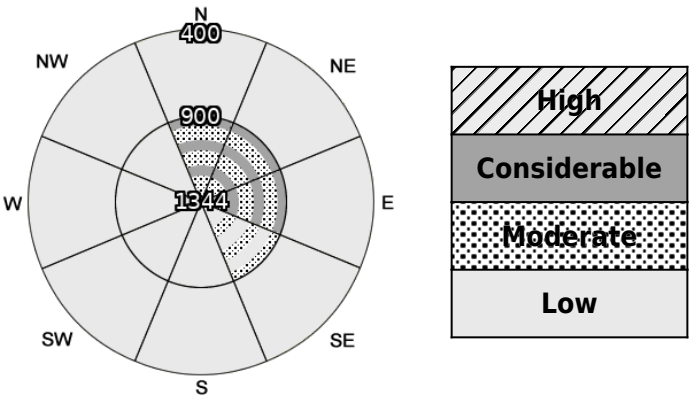
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will remain frozen and stable. Fresh unstable windslab will develop as the snow showers become established. Greatest accumulations will be on steep North, North-East and East aspects above 900 metres. Fresh cornices will also form above these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Increasing South-West winds with snow showers are expected during Thursday. The freezing level will rise to around 800m.
