

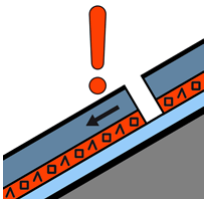

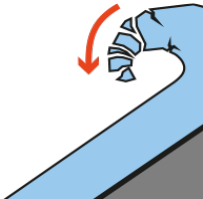

Wind Slab



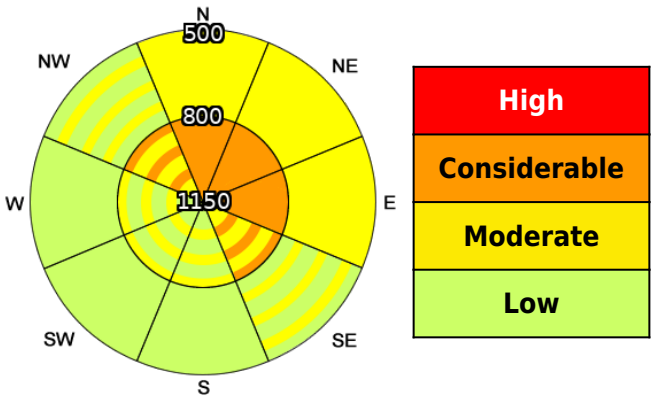
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of fresh unstable windslab will be deposited in sheltered areas, mainly on North to East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Other aspects, especially North-West and South-East, will be affected by cross loading. Fresh cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy snowfall above 600 metres is expected overnight; then snow showers during the day, initially above 600 metres, later above 300 metres. Winds are expected to be South-Westerly throughout the forecast period; moderate increasing to strong overnight, then strong easing to moderate during the day. The freezing level will be around 750 metres.
