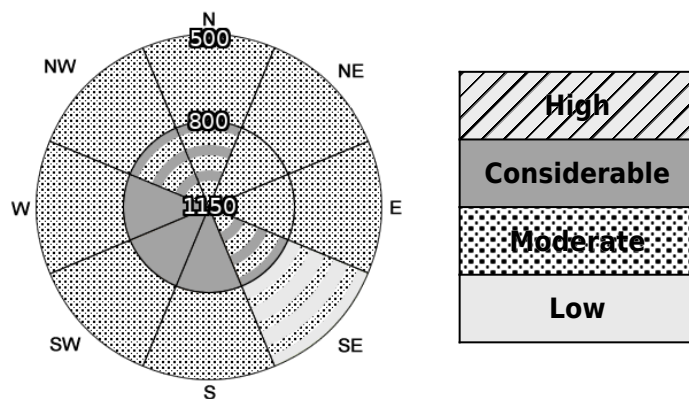

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will become firmer with new unstable windslab developing on mostly Southerly to Westerly aspects above 800 metres. Other aspects will be affected due to cross loading and older windslab will persist in some shelter locations. The windslab will be poor to weakly bonded, particularly on steeper terrain. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will strengthen from the North-East and bring moderate snowfall to valley level during the day.
