

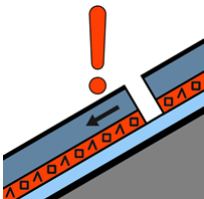

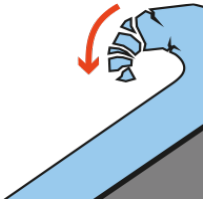

Wind Slab



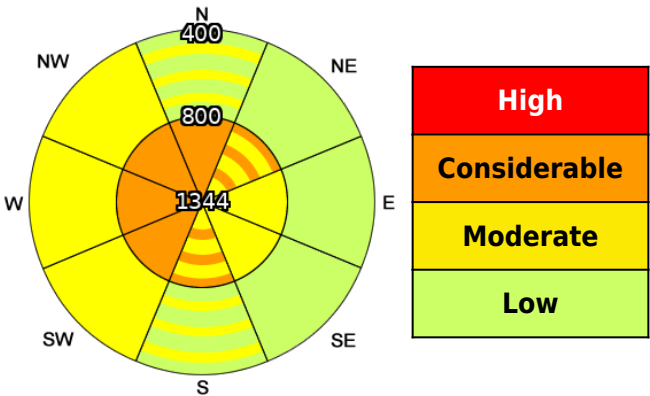
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will be present on many aspects. Greatest accumulations will be on South-West through West to North aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Other aspects will be affected by cross loading or by the presence of older windslab. Fresh cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers at most levels are expected throughout the forecast period, with strong or very strong Easterly winds. The freezing level will be 400 metres, dropping to 200 metres during the day.

Extremely poor visibility on Aonach Mor plateau and other upper parts of the hill.
