

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of poorly bonded windslab will continue to be deposited on South-West through West to North aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. On other aspects some areas will be affected due to cross loading and persistent unstable windslab while other areas will be scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold with temperatures below freezing at all levels and a strong Easterly wind. There will be some snow showers through out the period.
