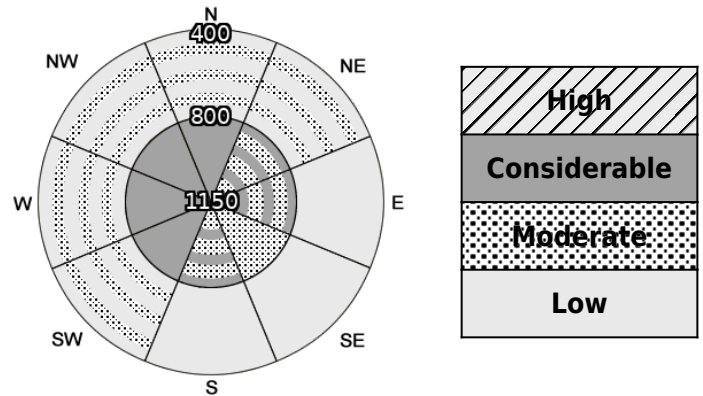

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Unstable windslab will exist on many slopes mainly above 800 metres. Greatest accumulations will be on slopes with a South-West through West to Northerly aspect where avalanches are likely. Sheltered areas such as summit gullies of other aspects will also be affected with weak deposits due to cross loading. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will remain cold with a strong South-Easterly airflow. It will be dry overnight with occasional or light snow snow through the course of the day.

**Comments**

Remaining very cold with strong winds. Weaknesses will continue to exist within deeper accumulations of windslab.
