

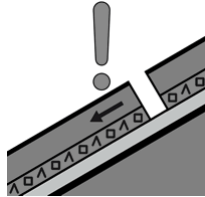

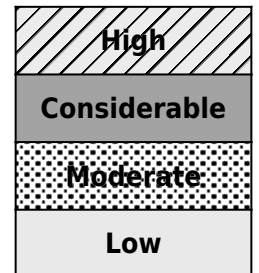
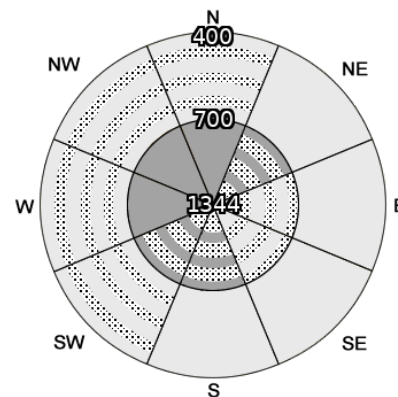
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snow showers and the redistribution of the existing snowpack in the strong winds will continue to add to the areas of unstable windslab which exist on West to North aspects above 700 metres. Other aspects will be affected due to cross loading. However, areas which are exposed to the full force of the wind will tend to be scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Very strong South-Easterly winds are expected. It will remain cold with temperature below freezing at all levels. After a dry night a few snow showers are expected during the day.
