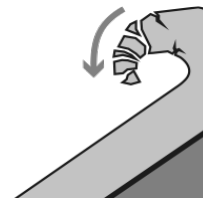

Wind Slab



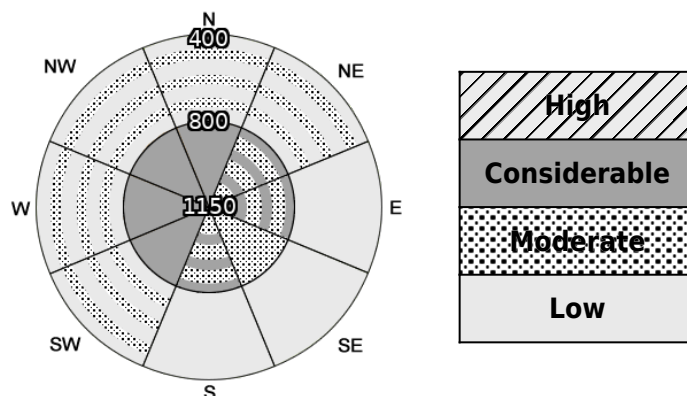
Persistent Weak Layers

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Deep unstable windslab will continue to develop on some South but mostly South-Westerly through Westerly to Northerly aspects above 800 metres and here avalanches are likely. On the same aspects at lower altitudes poor to weakly bonded windslab will be found on sheltered steeper terrain. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

There will be further snow showers overnight and during the day down to valley level. Winds will be strong from the South-East.

##### Comments

Some deep snow in sheltered locations. Very much full winter conditions on the mountains.
