

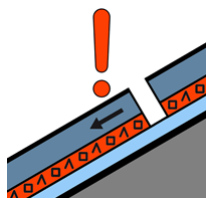

Wind Slab



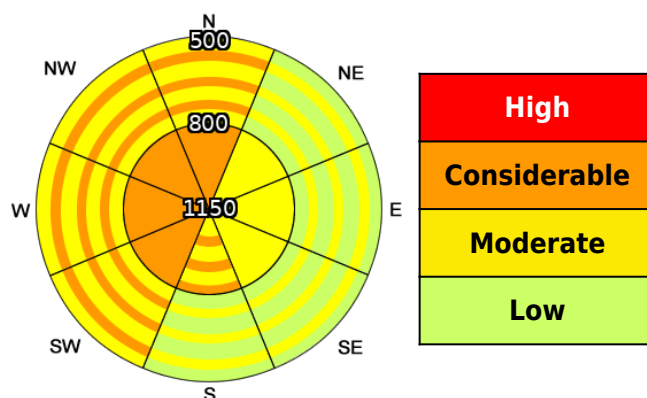
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poor to weakly bonded accumulations will be found mainly on South-Westerly through Westerly to Northerly aspects above 800 metres and here avalanches are likely. Localised accumulations of unstable windslab will also affect lower altitudes on steeper terrain and on other aspects due to cross-loading. Areas exposed to the wind will be scoured. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be some snow flurries at all levels throughout the forecast period. Overnight Easterly winds will ease slightly but will still be strong during the day.

Comments

Some very deep deposits in places but scoured in others. Careful route choice and planning required.
