

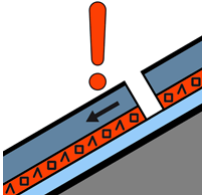

Avalanche Problems



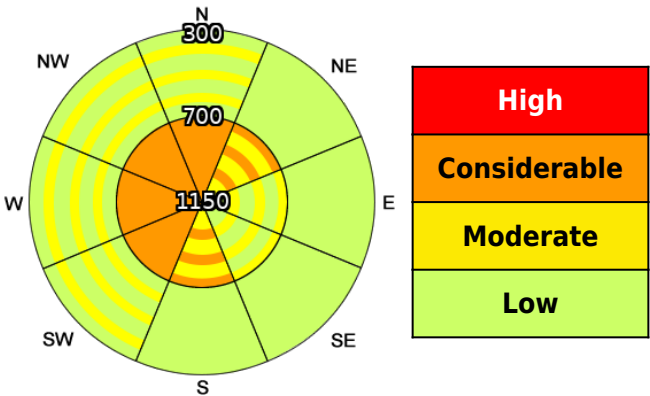
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Windslab of variable stability will persist mainly on South-West through West to North aspects above 700 metres. Some sheltered locations on other aspects will also be affected with windslab accumulations. However, where the snowpack has been exposed to the recent strong South-Easterly winds the snowpack is scoured and generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain cold with moderate Easterly winds. There will be some light snow through the day.

Comments

Weather is expected to remain cold and settled for a good few days. Little change is expected in snowpack conditions.
