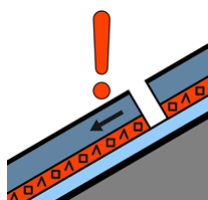

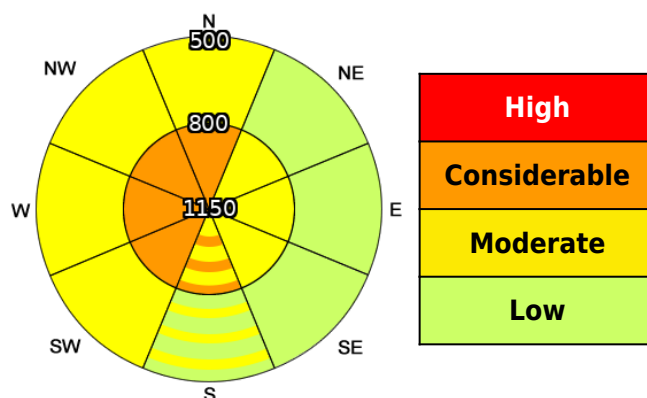
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poorly bonded windslab will be present on South through West to North aspects above 800 metres. Instabilities will also persist in older, hard, windslab lying mainly on these aspects, especially on steeper or convex terrain. Moderately bonded windslab will exist at lower levels especially on steeper slopes. Recently formed cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow flurries are expected, especially during the day, with light Easterly winds. The freezing level is expected to rise to 300 metres during the day.

Comments

Deep weaknesses persist in the snowpack below firm layers.
