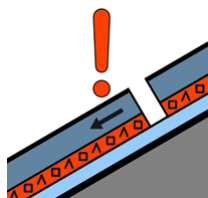

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 29/03/2013

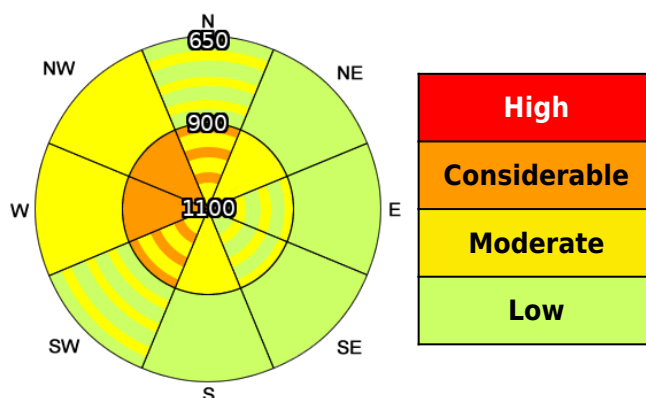
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability on East to South aspects and other locations exposed to recent local scouring. Cold temperatures will maintain near-surface and deeper instability on West to North-West aspects above 900m, with localised instability persisting on North and South-West aspects above the same altitude. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining cold with light Easterly winds. No precipitation forecast.

Comments

Persistent weak layers still evident. Strong slab supported by weak faceted snow taking a moderate additional load before failing. Thin, new weaker windslab in some sheltered areas. Remaining cold for the next few days.
