

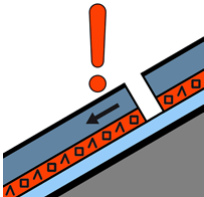

Wind Slab



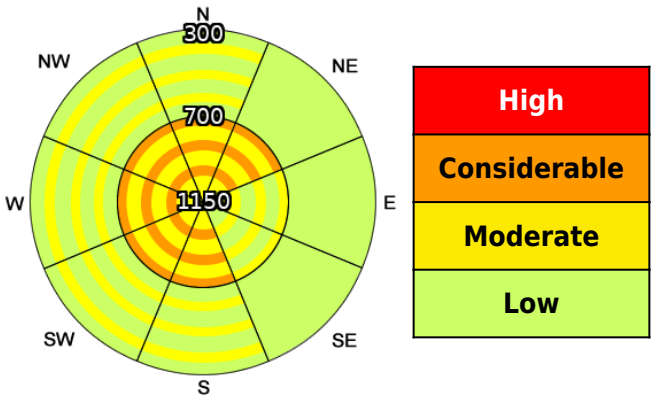

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected within the complex snowpack. Significant deposits of windslab of variable firmness and stability will exist on South through West to Northerly aspects above 700 metres. Variable stability within patches of windslab affecting other aspects, some accumulations will be well bonded, others will be quite unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a frosty night another dry and bright day is expected. Light winds will be from the South-East. The freezing level will rise to around 300 metres.
