

**Avalanche Problems**




Persistent Weak Layers

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Little change is expected in the snowpack. Areas of moderately bonded windslab will persist on South-West through West to North aspects above 800 metres. Some localised patches will be present on other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will remain dry. Light Southerly winds will back to the South-East and strengthen slightly. The freezing level will be around 350 metres.

**Comments**

Plenty of people out enjoying the hills. However, with a good range of climbing/walking/skiing options no one place was particularly busy.
