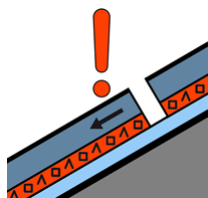
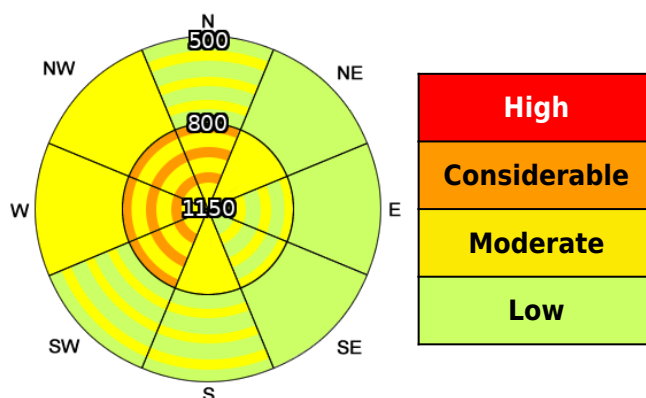


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 01/04/2013****Avalanche Problems****Persistent Weak Layers****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Instabilities will persist within the snowpack in the deeper deposits that exist on steeper slopes on mainly South-West through West to North aspects from 800 metres. Moderately bonded deposits will be present on other aspects and at lower altitudes. Solar warming will affect the stability of cornices and surface layers on South facing slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The cold high pressure system will continue to dominate. It will be dry and bright with light South-Easterly winds. Overnight freezing level of 300 metres will rise to 350 metres during the day.

Solar warming will affect the stability of cornices and surface layers on South facing aspects.
