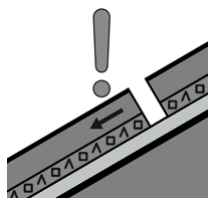

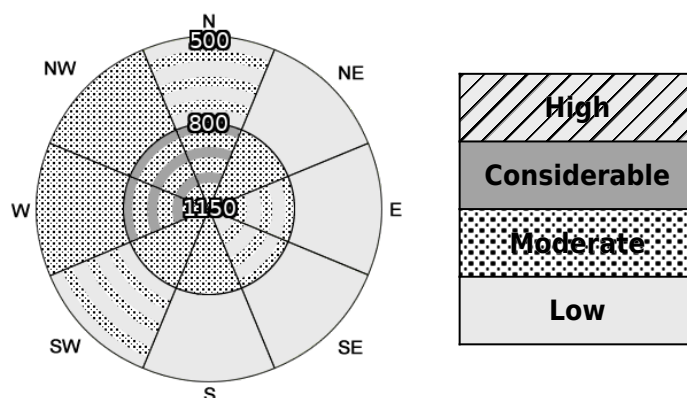
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some recently redistributed windslab will be found on West to North aspects above 900 metres. In steeper, shaded locations on these aspects from 800 metres, instabilities will persist within the snowpack due to a layer of sugar like faceted grains persisting at depth. Any sun warmed slopes will demonstrate some surface instability. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry overnight but there may be the occasional, very light snow shower during the day. The freezing level will rise from 350 to 550 metres but the summit temperatures will remain cold. Light South-Easterly winds.

Comments

Prolonged cold temperatures promoting the development of faceted grains.
