

#### Avalanche Problems




Persistent Weak Layers

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snowpack weaknesses will persist on mainly Westerly to Northerly aspects above 900 metres and mostly in areas of steep and convex terrain. Below this level and above 500 metres localised moderately well bonded accumulations persist in mainly steep lee areas. Easterly and wind exposed slopes will be mostly stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Dry overnight with a freezing level of 350 metres. During the day some light snow showers may occur above 350 metres. Winds will be light to moderate strength South-Easterly throughout the forecast period.

#### Comments

Cold and generally settled conditions will continue. Surface Hoar has formed in many areas.
