

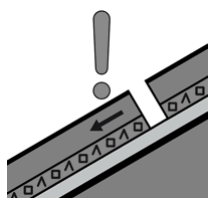

Wind Slab



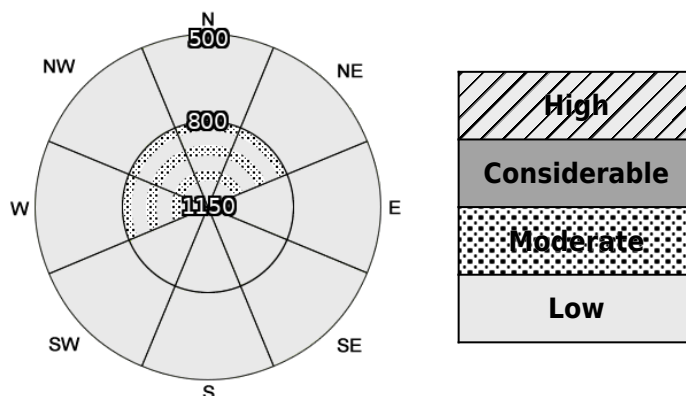
Persistent Weak Layers

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Little change is expected in the complex and variable snowpack. A persistent weak layer of sugary facets will continue to develop within the snowpack. Areas of poor and moderately bonded windslab of varying firmness will be found on mainly South-West through West to North aspects. Other aspects will also be affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will remain dry through the forecast period with moderate South-Easterly winds. The freezing level will rise to about 550 metres.

**Comments**

Despite the continuing dry and settled conditions, instabilities are being maintained or even further developing within the snowpack.
