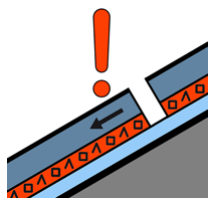

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 05/04/2013

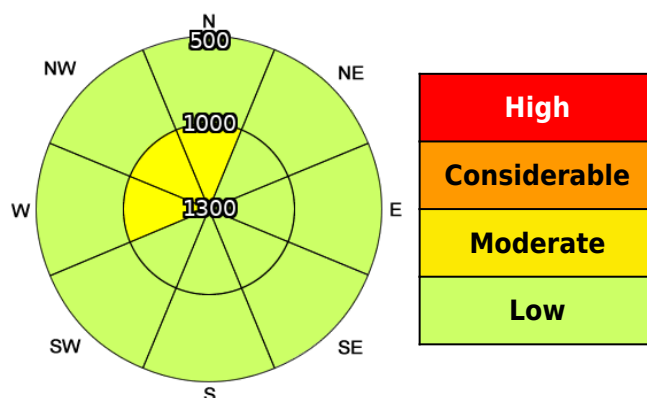
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected in the snowpack, Localised instabilities will persist high up in shaded terrain on West to Northerly aspects above 1000 metres, with very steep slopes and convex areas most affected. Elsewhere, snowpack stability will be generally good. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate strength North-Easterly winds overnight with some light snow showers possible, freezing at all levels. During the day the freezing level will rise to 500 metres, winds will be moderate Northerly, snow flurries may occur.
