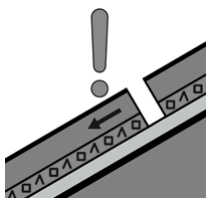

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 05/04/2013

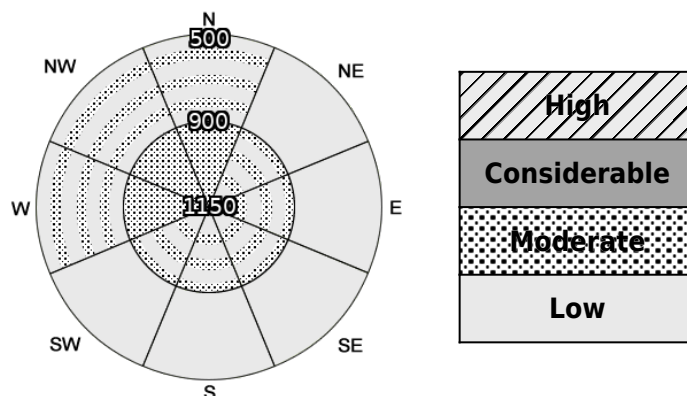
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh accumulations of windslab may form on South to West aspects above 900 metres overnight but these are not expected to be extensive. Localised areas of moderately bonded snow will be found in steeper locations on most aspects with more widespread distribution present on shaded West to North aspects above 900 metres. Any strong sun will cause surface instabilities on South facing aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

There may be some light snow showers overnight, with the possibility of a trace of new snow during the day. Overnight moderate North-Easterly winds will ease and back Northerly. The freezing level will rise from surface level to 500 metres during the day.
