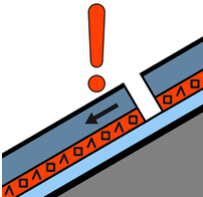

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 06/04/2013

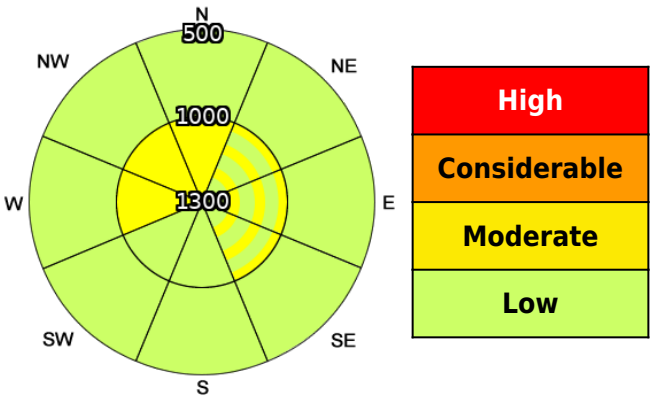
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

In general the snowpack will remain well bonded and stable. Localised instabilities will persist on steep and convex shaded West to North aspects above 1000 metres. Localised pockets of new windslab will develop on Easterly aspects mostly around corrie rims. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Occasional light snow showers are expected on light North then West winds. The freezing level will rise to 500 metres.

Comments

Large cornices overhanging W to N aspects above 500m. Could be prone to collapse especially at milder lower altitudes.
