

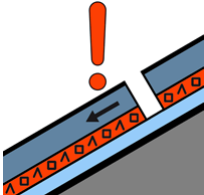

Avalanche Problems



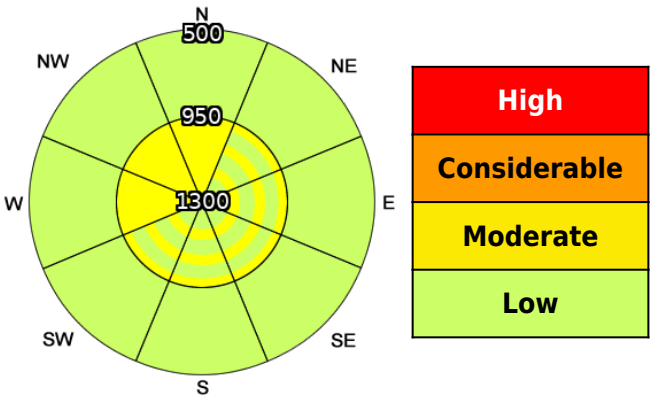
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snow instabilities will develop around corrie rims and steep terrain mostly on North-Easterly to South-Easterly aspects above 950 metres. Snowpack weaknesses will persist in steep convex areas on West to North aspects above 1000 metres. Elsewhere the snowpack will remain well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate snowfall expected overnight then light snow showers during Sunday. Light North-West winds will back to the South-West, freezing at all levels then rising to 500 metres during the day.
