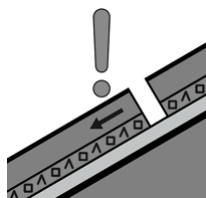
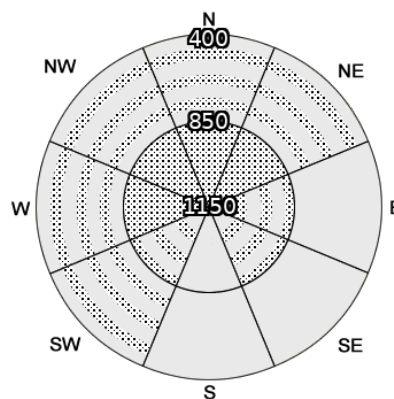


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 08/04/2013****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Persistent Weak Layers****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Areas of persistent instability will slowly moderate and be more localised as consolidation continues. However, buried weakly bonded, hard windslab layers will exist particularly on shaded, steeper slopes on West to Northerly aspects mainly above 850m. In other locations, the snowpack will be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Light snow showers with strong South-Easterly winds are forecast for the period. New accumulations of snow are not expected to be significant. Overnight, freezing at all levels then rising to 650 metres.
