

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weakly bonded windslab will continue to form on South-West through West to Northerly aspects above 900 metres with other aspects being affected due to cross loading. Most accumulations will be around corrie rims and in gully exits. Elsewhere the snowpack is generally well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong Easterly winds with occasional light snow showers are expected throughout the forecast period. Freezing at all levels overnight rising to 450 metres in the day.
