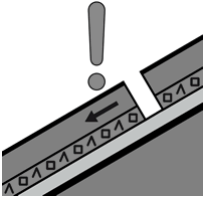

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 09/04/2013

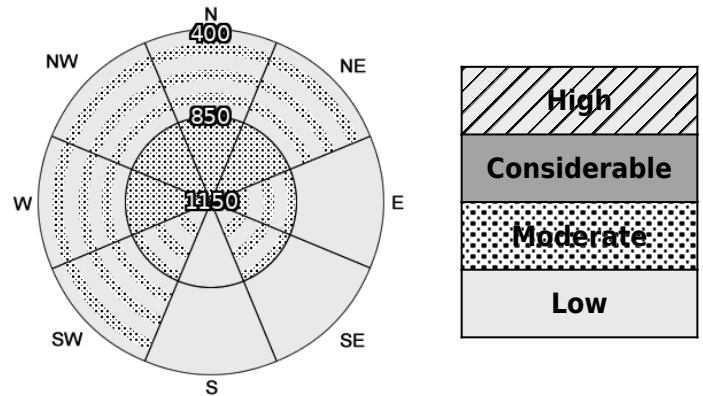
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected as cold conditions will maintain instabilities within the snowpack. Therefore; weakly bonded, hard windslab layers will persist particularly on steeper slopes with a West to Northerly aspect, mainly above 850m. In many places these layers overlie very firm snow ice and are poorly bonded. In other locations, the snowpack is generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

It should remain generally dry and cold with moderate Easterly winds. It will freeze at all levels this evening then rise to 450 metres.
