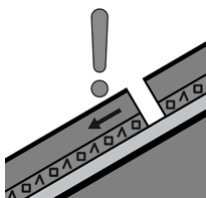

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 09/04/2013

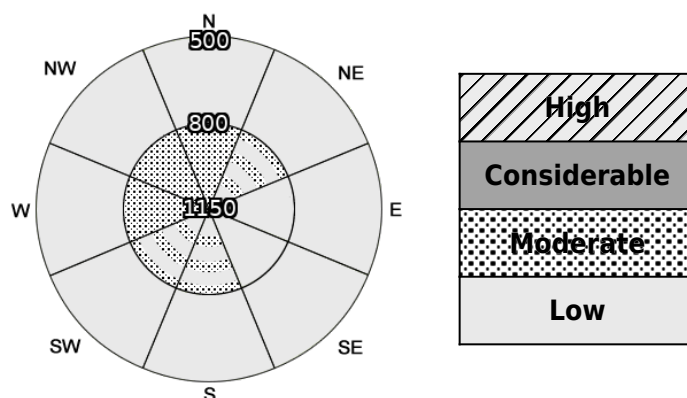
Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Limited drifting of deposits will form localised areas of fresh windslab on South-West through West to North aspects from 800 metres. Instabilities will also be present due to pre-existing weakness within the snowpack on these and other aspects. Many slopes will demonstrate good stability with generally well bonded snow. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

There may be a trace of snow overnight followed by some light snow showers during the day. Moderate Easterly winds. Remaining cold with a 450 metre freezing level.

Comments

Occasional pockets of deeper soft windslab especially in steeper, sheltered locations.
