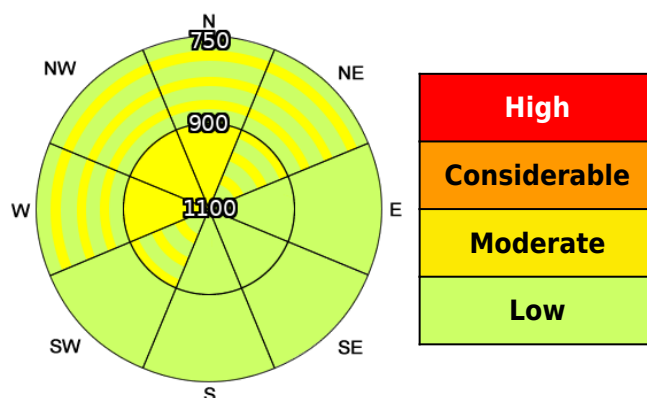
Wind Slab



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further accumulations of moderately bonded windslab may develop on South-West through West to Northerly aspects above 900 metres. Localised lingering weak layers will persist within the snowpack on North-West to North-East aspects. Elsewhere the snowpack will be generally well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Freezing at all levels overnight rising to 450 metres during the day with light snow showers. Winds will be Easterly, light to moderate in strength.
