

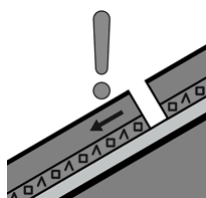

Avalanche Problems



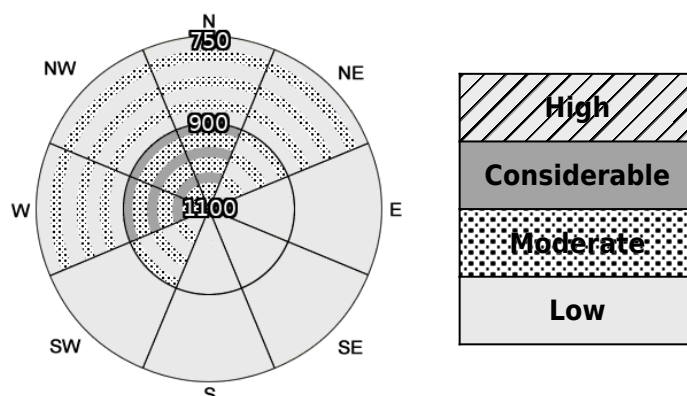
Wind Slab



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Wind slab will continue to build on West to North aspects above 900 metres where localised instabilities will form on gully tops and steep convex slopes. Elsewhere the snow pack will be generally well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The rather cold airstream will continue bringing a few light snow showers with moderate East-South-Easterly winds. Freezing level will rise from 400 metres to 700 metres during the forecast period.
