

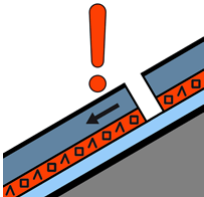

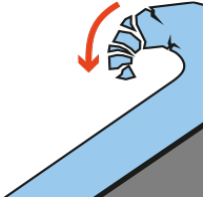

Wind Slab



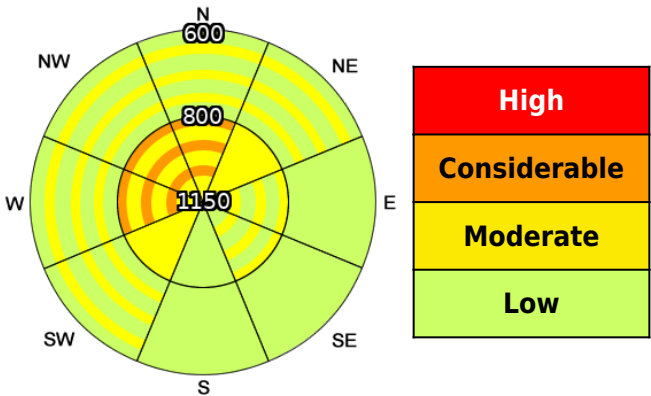
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Accumulations of new unstable windslab will continue to develop in sheltered areas with the greatest deposits on South-West through West to North aspects above 800 metres. On similar aspects, the older hard windslab deposits will still be present and also poorly bonded. New cornices will also be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight and through the day snow showers and light Easterly winds, the freezing level will be around 600 metres.

Comments

New snow amounts are uncertain but instabilities will remain within the snowpack.
